
Dear Mr. President:

As you know, Hurricane Irene is poised to deal a major blow to the East Coast. At this time, the National Weather Service has indicated that the storm is likely to pass directly over Rhode Island or to its West over the weekend. As such, Rhode Island may face a storm that is more powerful than any other it has experienced in decades.

The State of Rhode Island, the Rhode Island Emergency Management Agency, the Rhode Island National Guard, and local emergency planners are already mobilizing in preparation for this storm. We appreciate the steps FEMA has undertaken to reposition personnel and assets in Rhode Island in support of our state. Given the currently expected intensity of this storm as it nears Rhode Island, we urge you to support and expedite the approval of any forthcoming request for federal assistance, including any requests for emergency or disaster declarations from Governor Chafee.




